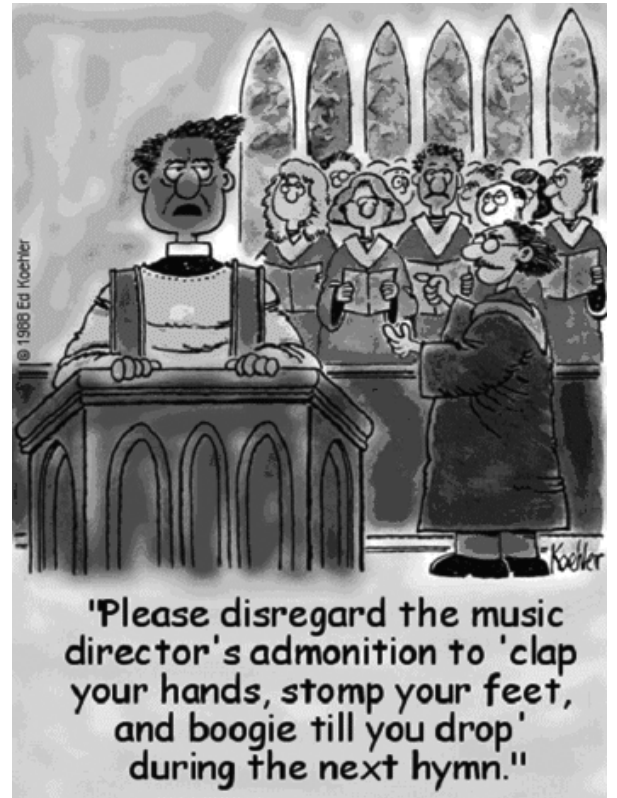
## Back Bay Mission
