Briefs from the Quarterly meeting October 21st

The new Church windows are paid in full. Thanks to everyone who supported the project.

Repairs have been made to the parsonage roof, windows will be replaced starting with the back door and dinette window this fall and the rest in the spring. Part of the rent money is being designated for repairs.

We have extended a three month contract to interim organist Ashley Stitt. She is a music major at Youngstown State University.

Audit of the church books will soon be underway. The trustees are satisfied with the rental agent Michelle May.

The Deaconate has filled the pulpit while Pastor Brown was in Biloxy and while he was on vacation. Sue Kowolic, Joan Ishibashi, Brenda Grauer, Jason Stankus and the youth group were used. Deaconate also held an ice cream social in September.

The proposed budget was set at \$70,000. The figure was approved by the congregation.

The Youth Group is actively seeking new members. They are participating in activities. Their proposed fund recipients for this year are suicide prevention and the heifer project.
